Position

Expectations

- Teach bible classes during scheduled times and lead frequent devotionals.
- Plan and lead retreats, trips, special events, etc.
- Assist with organizing and leading annual activities such as VBS, LTC, Friends & Family Day, etc.
- Regularly participate in worship services and be available to preach several times a year (as desired and needed).
- Assist in communicating a schedule of activities for the congregation.
- Manage volunteers, especially for children's and youth events.
- Keep an office presence/availability four days a week in addition to Sunday responsibilities (flexible and reasonable in relation to other activities going on) and participate in weekly staff and monthly elders' meetings.
