

Youth & Family Minister Goals & Expectations

Position

We are currently prayerfully seeking a man to become our next a full-time Youth & Family Minister. As a fellow member of this congregation, the minister will partner with us to lead people to Christ, encourage meaningful spiritual growth, and foster habits of lifelong discipleship in young people and beyond. There are no formal requirements for education, experience, or marital status for this position, though these things will be taken into consideration.

Goals

- Develop and implement a vision for the youth group and young families in collaboration with the eldership, deacons, and other staff.
- Promote a healthy spiritual atmosphere of grace and discipleship.
- Reach out to students and families in the hopes of leading them to Christ and becoming more involved in the life of our local congregation.
- Teach and instruct young people with a biblical and Christ-focused foundation.
- Manage volunteers who participate in youth and family activities.
- Contribute to a healthy Spirit-filled workplace environment in the church offices.
- Engage with the community and other local churches to promote the Kingdom of God.

Expectations

- Teach bible classes during scheduled times and lead frequent youth devotionals.
- Organize and lead retreats, trips, special events, etc.
- Assist with organizing and leading the annual activities we participate in such as VBS, LTC, etc.
- Regularly participate in worship services and be available to preach several times a year.
- Effectively communicate a schedule with the youth, parents, and the congregation.
- Work within a set budget.
- Be involved in the lives of the youth and family in our congregation and those being reached.
- Keep an office presence/availability four days a week in addition to Sunday responsibilities
 (flexible and reasonable in relation to other activities going on), and participate in weekly staff
 and monthly elders' meetings.

Compensation
